C.A.P. Meeting Minutes from September 19th, 2016

Meeting was called to order by President Mark McCusker at 7:06pm.

Treasurer Report: The budget is identical to last year's budget. The current balance is \$13,233.93. Only five out of eight scholarship checks have cleared. Meet the Team night was very successful, making \$660.00 for CAP. Three stadium seats, @\$45.00, and two seat cushions, @\$10.00, were sold at Meet the Team. Another \$70.00 was made at Orientation Night. \$50.00 from decal sales was made at the Monroe football game.

Lisa explained that in order to continue bonding insurance coverage, CAP must have an annual review by an outside source. In the past, ACE has provided this service for \$200.00. Mark McCusker knows someone that may be cheaper, and will get Lisa an estimate. Danielle moved and Heather seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Meeting Minutes: The June minutes were reviewed. A spelling correction is made for a CAP member's name. Lisa moved and Amy seconded that the June minutes be approved with the correction. The motion passed unanimously.

Athletic Program: All Fall sports have good numbers and have had a good start to their seasons. Volleyball has been undefeated so far in their division, football and soccer both had good wins against Plymouth.

There was a \$50.00 increase for Pay-to-play. It had been six years since the last increase. Attendance passes for the sporting events did not increase.

Committees:

Membership: So far there are 82 family and 21 lifetime memberships. This brings in \$1435.00. You can sign up online through PayPal, with the sign up cost being absorbed by CAP. Pay-to-play monies go to Central Office, not CHS. CAP membership monies go directly to the teams.

Bricks: Bricks were ordered in August. They should be delivered any day. If you order a brick now, it will be installed in Spring. A 4X8" brick costs \$55.00, and an 8X8" brick is \$100.00.

Wish List: There are currently no wish list items. The budget is \$2500.00. Last year CAP helped to fund four items.

Fall CAP 5K Run: The run is on November 12th. Angela has three sponsors confirmed, hoping to get 6-8 more. Sponsorship is \$100.00. A timer is lined up at a cost of \$500.00. If Gazelle is able to time the event, the cost for timing could go down.

Golf Outing: The golf outing is tentatively scheduled for June 11th, 2017.

Newsletter: Mark McCusker is asking CAP reps to collect and turn in emails of athletes/families, even if the team is not in season.

Coaches Corner Dinner: The dinner will be in January, the weekend of the NFC/AFC playoff game.

Hall of Fame Dinner: The location will be moved back to the Italian-American Club. Liz will be looking at March 15th or 16th, if available. Honorees are decided around Thanksgiving.

Christine Campbell moved and Ed Holton seconded that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting was adjourned at 7:55pm.
