**Treasurer Report:** The current balance is \$17,608.96. The balance in PayPal is \$675.21, \$42.81 of that is from membership. \$126.22 was paid to GoDaddy. Lisa is still waiting for an invoice from softball for the \$250.00 commitment from the wish list fund. Heather moved and Jan seconded that the Treasurer Report be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

**Meeting Minutes:** The February minutes were reviewed. Lisa moved and Joan seconded that the February minutes be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

**Athletic Program:** Marc recapped some of the winter seasons: Pom was 10<sup>th</sup> at Division I States; Cheer qualified for Regionals and was in top 20 at States; the Swim and Dive Team was second highest in the Conference, with Kevin Taylor, Nate Sutton and Patrick Holton qualifying for States, Patrick finished 17<sup>th</sup>, Kevin Taylor finished 15<sup>th</sup> and broke the school record in the 100M Butterfly ; Girls Basketball won Districts; the Hockey Team is Regional Champions; Gymnastics had 4 girls qualify for States.

Updating the KLAA information, Lakes Valley is the other conference and has nine teams. Grand Blanc will stay in our conference for 2017-18 only. Belleville will be in our conference for 2018-19. The 2018-19 Conference will be Churchill, Stevenson, Franklin, Belleville, John Glenn, Wayne Memorial and Salem. The Farmington schools are possibilities in the future. The other conference will be Novi, Plymouth, Canton, Northville, Howell, Hartland and Brighton.

### **Committees:**

**Scholarship:** The deadline for this year's CAP scholarship applications will be March 31, 2017. Mark, Angela, Jan and Joan will be judges. One more judge is needed.

**Hall of Fame Dinner:** The decorations are all set. There are currently 137 people going to the dinner. Last year there were approximately 60 people.
